Rules of Conduct and Contract of expectations for Reenactment Groups and Guilds Involving themselves with the Utah Midsummer Renaissance Faire. The Board of Directors of the Utah Midsummer Renaissance Faire would like to welcome you to Kedronvale and thank you for your interest and participation in the Faire. Over the past years, the Faire board has had to deal with many different situations, this has lead to the following guidelines being adopted. We ask that you read and understand that these are not a set of negotiations, but the requirements you are to follow while being involved with the Utah Midsummer Renaissance Faire.

1. All Mundane Laws are to be followed, without exception.
 2. NO Alcohol is permitted. Kedonvale is a dry site. The Cedar City Main Street Park is dry by Cedar City Ordinance. Please don't push this, as it will result in the immediate expulsion of your group/guild from the Utah Midsummer Renaissance Faire, regardless of the time of Day or Night.
 3. All instructions received from the Utah Midsummer Renaissance Faire board are to be followed.
 4. Any group engaging in Period style combat will adhere to the following:
 - a. Only your membership will engage in combat. No audience participation! (No audience members in your eric, no audience members handling weapons!)
 - b. A member of the Utah Midsummer Renaissance Faire will check your Eric. If found unsatisfactory, no combat will take place until corrections are made.
 - c. Any reports of unsafe activities will be investigated and a decision will be made regarding the continuation of the activities investigated.
 - d. A legal adult (a person 21 years or older, as defined by Utah State Law), will be present at all times during combat activities.
 - e. Archery is not permitted, except for by special permission.
 - f. No cross combat, e.g. If you are a steel/rattan group, you are not permitted to allow a foam fighting group to use your eric/arena. This is not negotiable and will result in immediate expulsion from the faire.
 - g. All forms of Martial activities must be cleared by the Faire Board.
 5. The wear of garb is expected
 6. Groups and their royalty are welcome in the twice daily Royal Processional. Kedronvale has it's own royalty and we welcome our royal cousins, but they are our cherished guests, and should remember this and conform themselves as such.
 7. Everyone in your encampment area will be in garb.
 8. There will be no smoking on the Faire grounds, which includes the use of E-Cigarettes and no Vaping by ordinance of Cedar City Corporation.
